Category	Supports / Accommodations
<b>Academic Support</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Early registration for classes</li> <li>• Modification of assignments (length, due dates, etc.)</li> <li>• Breaking down assignments into smaller parts</li> <li>• Frequent short quizzes</li> <li>• Alternative testing (e.g., presentations)</li> <li>• Access to professor notes</li> <li>• Permission to record lectures</li> <li>• Early syllabus distribution</li> <li>• Reduced course load</li> </ul>
<b>Notetaking &amp; Technology</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-class note taker</li> <li>• Assistive tech (voice-to-text)</li> <li>• Notetaking apps</li> <li>• Recording devices</li> <li>• Audiobooks</li> <li>• Calculators</li> <li>• Noise-canceling headphones</li> </ul>
<b>Dormitory Accommodations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Single room option</li> <li>• RAs trained in disability services</li> <li>• Low-stimulation environments</li> </ul>
<b>Classroom Environment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Preferential seating</li> <li>• Quiet rooms</li> <li>• Movement or frequent breaks</li> </ul>
<b>Testing &amp; Exams</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Extended exam time</li> <li>• Use of laptop</li> <li>• Quiet testing location</li> <li>• Verbal instead of written</li> <li>• Use of notes (if permitted)</li> </ul>
<b>Financial &amp; Program Flexibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Extended academic year for same tuition</li> <li>• 5-year graduation with 4-year tuition</li> </ul>
